SUMMARY

This weekend we heard from Brian McKenney. We looked at an interesting story from Judges 3 and found eight incredible insights. The title of the message was "Enough is Enough".

- (1) God can even use our failures to grow us (v.1-5).
 - · Can you share an example of how this has been true in your life?
- (2) When it comes to sin: what we don't eradicate, we will end up embracing (v.6)
 - What in your life needs to be eradicated? How will you go about it?
- (3) You will bring tribute. The choice is this: will you worship the One who gives you freedom? Or the things that enslave you (v.12-17)?
 - What does is it mean to "bring tribute"? How does this play out in your life currently?
- (4) When we choose to feed the flesh, we forfeit the greater things God has for us (v.18-19).
 - What does it mean to "feed the flesh".
 - · How do you choose the things God has over feeding the flesh?
- (5) Your handicap does not stop God's handiwork (v.20-21).
 - · What is your handicap? How have you seen God use it?
 - (6) We will never get rid of sin in our lives until we see it for what it is (v.22).
 - Is there any sin in your life that God has revealed to you recently that you need to get rid of?
 - (7) "When the sword goes in, the dirt comes out." Jon Courson
 - Read Hebrews 4:12 How might you grow in dedication to God's word this week?
 - (8) Your people are waiting for you to lead (v.23-30).
 - · Who is waiting for you to lead?
 - · What would likely happen if you did?
